



EDI was approached by the Starkville School District to provide a comprehensive analysis of the district's athletic facilities. A recent construction project added a new sixth-grade building to the Armstrong campus, which has strained the capacity of the existing gymnasium. Moreover, the existing gymnasium is not air conditioned and is very hot in August, September, and May.

Initially, we looked at renovating the gymnasium. At the district's request, we changed direction and produced a preliminary design for a new multi-purpose building. Later, the multi-purpose building was expanded to include bleachers, making it viable as a new competition space. The existing gymnasium will receive minor renovations and will continue to serve as additional capacity for P.E. classes.
